

## COVID – 19 DAILY ROUTINE & GENERAL INFORMATION

### DROP OFF & PICK UP

- Please complete the [Health Check](#) prior to arriving at CHCCS.
- If your child is symptomatic please keep them home and call Public Health at 811 for next steps.
- Parents are asked to email [cityhallchildcare@telus.net](mailto:cityhallchildcare@telus.net) & [chccs@outlook.com](mailto:chccs@outlook.com) if child is symptomatic and with information obtained from Public Health.
- COVID test results are not required.
- Parents are expected to wear a mask when in parkade stairwell and while in the drop off and pick up area.
- Transport your child's belongings to and from daycare using the reusable bag provided to you by daycare.
- Reusable bags are washed between each use.
- Please do not enter the daycare yard. Staff will greet you and conduct the routine with your child.
- All Infant & U3 children will enter the daycare at the Infant Program gate.
- All O3 children & Staff will enter the daycare at the north gate.
- Staff will greet your child, transfer belongings. Provide hand sanitizer for children Over 3.
- Say good bye to your child prior to receiving hand sanitizer and entering the yard.
- Your O3 child will receive hand sanitizer before exiting the yard and greeting you.

### BATHROOM & HANDWASHING

- All children will wash hands when soiled, upon entering the inside play space, after diapering and toileting routine and prior to eating etc.
- Children will be gently reminded, encouraged and guided to use effective hand washing and to use cough and cover procedure

### FREEPLAY & SNACK

- Please leave toys, hair accessories, jewelry at home –we discourage bringing items from home that are not necessary for daycare.
- Children will be offered snack or they may choose to play until ready to eat.
- Children will wash hands prior to joining the snack/lunch table
- Activities offered during this time include teacher directed art activity with a friend, story time, music, dancing and yoga.

### LUNCH

- Children will sit at the tables in small groups
- Staff will assist with opening containers and thermos.

### REST TIME

- Sheets and rest mats are stored separately. Washed weekly and when soiled.
- Parents send small blankets that are able to fit in a small container.
- Blankets will be sent home for parents to wash each week or when soiled.
- We discourage sleep toys and soft toys for rest time at daycare.

### OUTSIDE TIME:

- It is not unusual for children to have runny noses and slight coughs when playing outside and exerting energy.
- Staff closely monitor each child for possible symptoms and will notify families when children present concerning symptoms.

Each day teachers engage with your child, observe play, provide activities and facilitate interactions between children. Our priority is to normalize this unique situation while providing a safe, positive, fun environment while guiding and educating the children in a positive manner.
